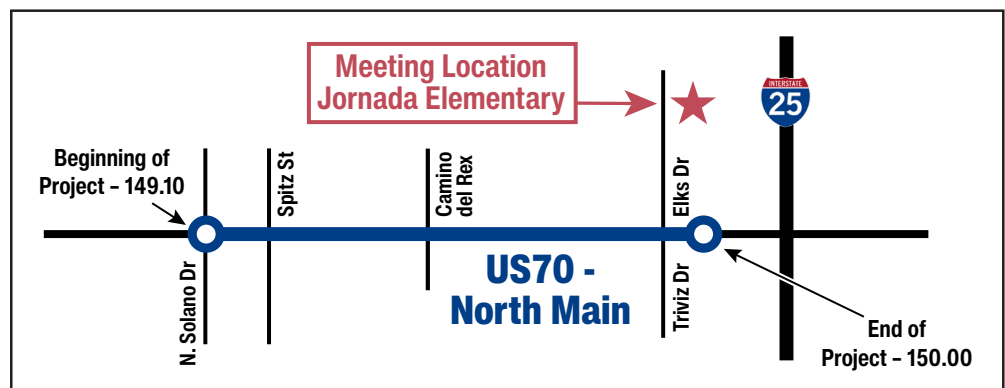
Purpose of Project

The project includes improvements on 1.048 miles of US 70/North Main Street from Milepost 149.10 to Milepost 150 (Elks Drive/N. Triviz Drive).

The purposes of the project are to improve traffic flow, safety and storm drainage. Construction is scheduled to begin **Monday, January 29, 2024** and last through **October 2024**.

Benefits of Project

- Add one lane in each direction (eastbound and westbound) for a total of three lanes in each direction on US 70/North Main Street in the project area
- Construct box culverts to improve drainage at the Alameda Arroyo Trail
- Add a new traffic signal at the intersection of US 70/ North Main Street and Elks Drive/N. Triviz Drive
- Install new curb and gutter
- Install new sidewalks
- Install new roadway striping and signage



Purpose of Meeting

At this meeting, the construction team will review anticipated construction phases, expected traffic impacts and the timeline for project construction. Team members will also answer questions and receive comments.
