### FAQ

**What is an ICIP?** This is an Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP) that is updated annually. It is a *planning tool* that establishes priorities for anticipated projects and covers a 5-year fiscal period. It is *not* a wish list, a funding application, or funding source.

**Why is the ICIP important?** The plan establishes priority projects and helps the County identify and focus on critical needs projects, increases our funding opportunities, and allows for proper planning and development of capital improvements.

**What should an ICIP do?** Projects should:

- create a new fixed asset;
- enhance an existing fixed asset;
- have a life expectancy of, at least, 10 years;
- typically over \$10,000.00 in cost;
- have good estimates;
- be ready to proceed.
