What You Need to Know

Who Can Participate:

- Local organizations interested in hosting ABC Suicide Prevention Classes.

What SFCC Provides:

- **Curriculum:** SFCC-NMSPI will cover the cost of the training materials.
- **Certified Trainer:** SFCC-NMSPI will fund and schedule an experienced ABC trainer to lead the session.
- **Registration System:** SFCC-NMSPI will manage the registration process for attendees.
- **Local Promotion:** Assistance with promoting the training to ensure strong attendance, if needed.
- **Other Expenses:** Other reasonable, preapproved training related expenses may be considered.

What You Provide:

- **Training Room:** A space that can accommodate 25 participants.
- **Audio/Visual Equipment:** Ensure all necessary A/V tools are available for the training.
- **Local Promotion:** Help spread the word to potential attendees in your community.
